

This week's clinics are now full

We have invited over 900 patients for a vaccination this week from cohort 6, which is; patients aged 16-64 who are clinically vulnerable. Unfortunately we only had 680 vaccines and all of these appointments have now been taken.

When you arrive for your appointment, we will call you in at your appointment time, so those who arrive too early may have to wait

We do not know yet when the next delivery of vaccine is

– watch this space for updates

Patients in cohort 5 (those aged 65-69) should have received an invitation from the national booking service to attend a vaccination centre or community pharmacy setting –see below for details of how to book

We have to stick to the national programme when allocating appointments for the vaccine, but we receive lots of requests from patients to 'move up the queue'. Some of these patients are now taking up appointment slots to speak with a doctor to get preferential treatment. These are appointment slots meant for patients who are unwell 😞

Please understand - if you are eligible we will contact you If you are not you will not be offered an appointment so please wait for your turn
